NATURE PRESCHOOL TEACHER JOB DESCRIPTION

PURPOSE OF THE POSITION

The Nature Preschool Teacher will share Schlitz Audubon Nature Center's mission primarily as a full-time teacher of nature-based early childhood programming for children ages 3-5. The Nature Preschool Teacher will co-lead two preschool classes with up to 16 children per class for the duration of the school year and will contribute to the overall support and well-being of the preschool. The preschool year runs from September to June. Additionally, the Nature Preschool Teacher is responsible for co-leading some summer camps between June and August. This position reports to the Nature Preschool Director.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

- Work collaboratively with co-teachers and staff to fulfill the mission of the preschool
- Assume responsibility for the health, safety and welfare of all children in the group
- Ensure that the program classroom operates within the guidelines of the Wisconsin Department of Children and Families and meets best practices in nature-based early childhood education
- Supervise children indoors and out, throughout the seasons, and in all types of weather and terrain
- Respond quickly and professionally to unsafe conditions that may put children at risk
- Facilitate communication and positive relationships with parents and coworkers
- Participate in Parent-Teacher conferences, orientations, and occasional preschool events outside regular classroom hours
- Develop and sustain appropriate working relationships with other Center employees
- Collaborate with staff to periodically review Nature Preschool policies and procedures
- Participate in regular preschool team meetings
- Maintain confidentiality
- Abide by the Center's health and safety protocols, including the current COVID-19 guidelines
- There is an expectation that Nature Preschool teachers will teach a portion of early childhood summer camps every year between June and August

ADDITIONAL DUTIES

- Assure the safe, beautiful, and stimulating atmosphere of the classroom by organizing and caring for the room and its contents, including live herpetological animals (turtles, salamanders, frogs)
- · Participate when possible in Center-wide planning, meetings, initiatives and events
- Document children's daily activities using digital photography
- Provide general support of the Nature Preschool during weekly office hours
- Be available to sub for other teachers if possible
- Other duties as assigned

QUALIFICATIONS

- Degree in Early Childhood Education or related field preferred
- Knowledge of Environmental Education preferred
- Minimum of 2 years teaching experience in early childhood or Nature Center setting preferred
- Must possess, or be willing to acquire, First Aid and CPR certification within 30 days of hire
- Must be able to pass a fingerprinting and background check within 30 days of hire
- Must be willing to undertake 25 hours of ongoing professional development per year
- Effective verbal and written communication skills
- Ability to perform tasks requiring physical exertion, outdoors, in all weather conditions and on difficult terrain
- Ability to work on a computer, up to 2 hours at a time, on occasion
- Proficiency in Outlook, Word, and Publisher as well as a willingness to learn other platforms such as Google Photos, Adobe Spark, etc.
- Regularly required to stoop and bend
- Occasionally required to reach above the shoulders
- Must have the ability to lift and/or move up to 35 pounds on occasion
- Must have the ability to speak and hear
- Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision and color vision
